Itemization of Services

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff \$1,295

Our fee for basic services of the funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to:

Responding to the initial request for service; conducting the arrangement conference; preparation of biographical and statistical data; examination of financial settlement options; preparation and filing of papers, permits, authorizations; coordination with those providing other services; preparation and placement of obituary notices; retention and care prior to commencement of services; overhead expenses relative to our facility and operations such as occupancy, administrative, and equipment costs. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. *(This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)*

Embalming \$795

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Use of Facilities and Staff for Viewing/Visitation at Funeral Home \$400

Services include: Setup of the visitation area, placement of remains, positioning of floral displays, supervision and attendance during the hours of visitation, and parking lot assistance. This charge also includes local transportation to final committal.

Use of Facilities, Equipment and Staff for Funeral Ceremony at Funeral Home/Gathering/Memorial Service \$400

Services include: Setup of the visitation area, placement of remains, positioning of floral displays, supervision and attendance during the hours of visitation, and parking lot assistance, arrangement and supervision of memorial service/ceremony/gathering as well as final committal.

Identification Viewing \$395

Cremation Care \$595

Witnessing of Cremation \$450

This fee includes use of the facilities, staff and crematory operator during the witnessing of a scheduled cremation at our on-site crematory, for up to one hour. During this time period, you may wish to have your clergy present to conduct a brief prayer service, if desired. This fee will be added to any cremation packages as an upgraded option.

Use of Equipment and Staff for Graveside Service – Final Committal \$295

Services include: Accompaniment of remains or cremated remains to cemetery, arrangement and supervision of graveside service, staff to attend final committal service.

All arrangements/services are Monday-Friday, 9am-4pm. Outside of these hours an additional charge of \$500 will apply.

Forwarding of Remains (to another funeral home)	\$1,995
<p>Services include: Transfer of remains to another funeral home, basic services of funeral director and staff, embalming, coordination with other service providers, transferring the remains to the airport or other destination. Fee does not include casket or alternative shipping container, use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony prior to forwarding or sheltering of remains, or charges of common carrier.</p>	
Receiving Remains (from another funeral home)	\$1,995
<p>Services include: Receiving remains from another funeral home, the overnight sheltering of remains, basic services of funeral director and staff, obtaining necessary permits and authorizations, and local (<i>within 25 miles</i>) transportation to cemetery or crematory. Fee does not include use of facilities and staff for visitation or ceremony, nor does it include transferring of the remains from the airport or other source, or the charges of commons carrier.</p>	
Immediate Burial Excluding Casket (see Casket Price List)	\$2,995-\$3,295
<p>Services include: Basic services of funeral director and staff, local (<i>within 25 miles</i>) transfer of remains to funeral home, overnight sheltering of remains, obtaining necessary permits and authorizations, local transportation to cemetery, and sanitary care and preparation of remains for identification. Fee does not include use of facilities or staff for any visitation or ceremony, nor does it include the actual cost of grave at the cemetery, or cemetery charge for opening and closing the grave.</p>	
Immediate burial with minimum, non-sealed metal casket	\$3,295
Immediate burial with container provided by purchaser	\$2,995
Direct Cremation (range of prices)	\$1,495-\$1,695
<p>Services include: Basic services of funeral director and staff, local (<i>within 25 miles</i>) transfer of remains to funeral home, overnight sheltering of remains, refrigeration for up to two days, obtaining necessary permits and authorizations, photo identification only, local transportation to crematory and charges for the cremation process. Fee does not include use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to cremation. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard composition materials (<i>with or without an outside covering</i>).</p>
